



The memory of great scientist Georg Cantor (best known as the inventor of set theory, which has become a fundamental theory in mathematics) is now immortalized in Saint Petersburg.

The opening of memorial plaque was conducted on October, 11th on Visilievsky Island, line 11, building 24. In this building the future famous mathematician was born and lived since 1845 to 1854.
